### Top uranium producing companies in the world

Kazakhstan, Canada and Australia are the major producers of uranium, accounting for more than two-thirds of the world's production. The top 10 uranium producing companies control 86% of the world's uranium production. Here is the list of top uranium producing companies in the world:

### 1/Kazatomprom (Kazakstan) 21%

World's largest producer, 12,488 tons U in 2017, or 21% of world production. Has largest reserve base in the industry, with reserves of 300 ktU. Operates 26 deposits grouped into 13 mining assets located in Kazakhstan.

### 2/Cameco (Canada) 15%

One of the world's largest publicly traded uranium companies. In 2017, the company produced 9,155 tons U, or 15% of world production. Their operations in <u>Canada</u> and <u>Kazakhstan</u> can produce over 53 million pounds annually, and has nearly 458 million pounds of proven and probable uranium reserves on three continents.

### 3/Orano (France) 13%

In 2017, the company produced 8,031 tons U, accounting for 13% of the world's uranium production. Produces and enriches to make fuel for nuclear reactors. Main uranium production sites are in <u>Canada, Niger and Kazakhstan</u>. In April 2017, Orano signed a strategic agreement with KazAtomProm to strengthen cooperation in uranium mining.

# 4/Uranium One (Russia) 7%

A wholly owned by Rosatom, it is a Canadian uranium mining company with headquarters in Toronto, Ontario. The company produced 5,102 tons U in 2017, and is responsible for <u>Rosatom's uranium production outside the Russian Federation</u>. It is also engaged in the exploration and development of uranium properties, in <u>Kazakhstan, the US, Tanzania and other countries</u>. The firm generates a significant part of its revenues from the sale of uranium concentrates. It sells its uranium to major nuclear utilities in Russia, Europe, North America, South America, Middle East and Asia.

# 5/CNNC & CGN (China) 4%

Produced 3,897 tons U in 2017, or 4% of the world's uranium production. China National Uranium (CNUC) is a CNNC subsidiary that is involved in uranium mining domestically and internationally.

# 6/ARMZ Uranium Holding (Russia) 5%

It produced 2,917 tons U in 2017, accounting for 5% of the total uranium production in the world. Manages Russian uranium mining assets in the <u>Trans-Baikal</u>, the Republic of Buryatia, and Kurgan region.
